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## SCHOOL PROFILE

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At Score Academy's four school locations in south Florida, individualization and customization guide our work with students. We are accredited by Cognia and the Southern Association of Colleges & Schools Council on Accreditation and School Improvement (SACS CASI), and are approved by SEVIS for international students. The College Board has individually approved our AP courses and teachers. Core courses in all our schools are accepted by the NCAA Eligibility Center. Our Palm Beach County schools are approved to accept Florida's McKay, FTC, Gardiner, and Hope Scholarships.

Score Academy offers full-time and part-time private schooling to students who choose to learn in our intentionally small group or 1-on-1 setting. During a full school day Monday through Friday, full-time students typically take 4-5 core academic courses and up to 2 electives each semester. We also create programs for part-time students to meet their specific needs (e.g., a plan combining independent study with scheduled class time, or one in which a student takes some classes at Score Academy and other classes at another school or through an accredited online provider, such as Florida Virtual School).

Score Academy develops an individual education plan for every student to match his/her specific learning style and personal goals. We offer courses in all subject areas across all grade levels, from kindergarten through 12<sup>th</sup> grade, and at all educational levels, from remedial and regular to honors and AP. We also offer advanced-level courses for students requiring additional rigor beyond the AP curriculum, including Multi-Variable Calculus, Linear Algebra and Post-AP English.

### College Preparatory Diploma Requirements

- English: 4 years
- Mathematics: 4 years (Algebra I & 2; Geometry; plus one, more advanced year-long course)
- Science: 3 years (including biology with lab)
- Social Science: 3 years (World History, US History, Government/Economics)
- Foreign Language: 2 years (same language)
- PE/Health: 1 year
- Computers/Life Skills: 1 year
- Arts: 1 year
- Electives: 5 years (including Black, Hispanic, and Holocaust Studies)

Our faculty engage students through a variety of teaching methods that complement each student's unique learning style. They communicate effectively, in part, because of their passion for teaching.

Because Score Academy focuses on the academic needs, learning style, and personality of each and every student, we are in a position to accept anyone who has the potential to succeed in our environment. Open enrollment enables us to accept students throughout the school year, not just at the start of a semester. Ideal candidates for our private schools are those students who...

- need flexible scheduling due to demanding schedules in athletics or performing arts,
- desire the benefits of the highest level of education with the lowest student-teacher ratio,
- require a smaller, more nurturing environment with engaging teachers, and/or
- have specific learning needs or disabilities.

Like most other schools, Score Academy gives students homework, research assignments, quizzes, tests, and exams. Score Academy keeps parents up-to-date with weekly progress reports; we issue report cards on a quarterly basis and official transcripts at the end of each school year.
